

Environmental Bills (2026 Regular Legislative session)

HB5 by Representative [Mike Johnson](#)

ENERGY: Authorizes parish governing authorities and citizens to determine whether Class VI injection wells, carbon dioxide sequestration, and carbon dioxide pipelines may be permitted within a parish

ENERGY: Declares that carbon dioxide sequestration is illegal without a property owner's consent

ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL: Prohibits the intentional release or dispersion, by burning of fuel, of chemicals into the environment of this state with the express purpose of affecting temperature. (8/1/26)
